Portsmouth Public Schools offer Horticulture I (Greenhouse Plant Production and Management-8036) during the fall semester and Horticulture II (Nursery and Landscape Management-8035) during the spring semester. The two block courses are open to interested juniors and seniors who can earn two high school credits per semester and a verified credit upon successfully passing the state certification exams. A Registered Technician Pesticide Applicator License is available in the spring.
